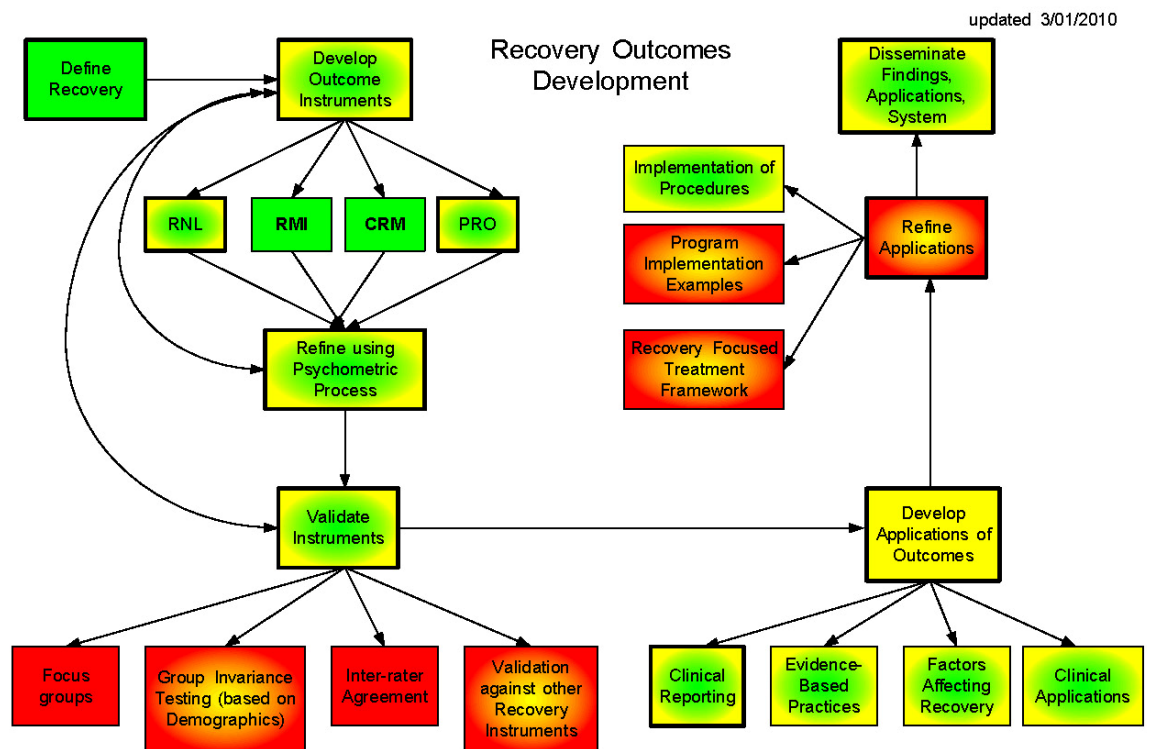
We can train your consumers so you can have in-house research teams. We train consumers every year on basic research and survey methods, confidentiality and data entry.
